No other roll film reflex camera allows you to change formats from 6 x 6 or 6 x 4.5 cm to normal 35 mm (24x36mm) and 35 super panoramic (24 x 54mm) or Polaroid in a matter of seconds! Only BRONICA give you a choice of cameras, systems, formats, lenses, accessories and film emulsions not available from other makers. BRONICA have taken advantage of today's electronic technology to shrink the

size of the traditional roll film reflex cameras smaller, lighter and easier to handle, but the replacement of mechanical parts with dependable solid-state circuitry has made them much more reliable. Couple this with an appreciation of what photographers want in real, practical terms and you go some way toward understanding the world wide success of the BRONICA systems.

ERONICA ETR-5

This superb 6x4.5 SLR camera has found favour amongst a host of practical photographers for a variety of reasons, not least of which is its outstanding versatility. Thanks to the unique Speed Grip it handles almost as fast as a 35mm SLR. Horizontal or vertical use are equally quick and easy to manoeuvre. The ZENZA BRONICA ETR-S has what is often described as the 'ideal format,' 4.5 x 6 cm, with a side/length ratio very close to matching standard paper and reproduction sizes, especially the very popular 10x8 and 11x14in. printing papers. This means less trimming when enlarging, for you can use the full negative area efficiently and economically. With a negative area almost three times as large as the 35mm format and a range of highly

superior, high performance ZENZANON E lenses, image quality is of the very highest order. In spite of its compactness the BRONICA ETR-S lacks nothing in the way of the practical features demanded by the professional user. For instance, the ETR-S user can quickly change form 35mm film (in the standard 24x36 or 24x54 panaoramic format) to 120 (15 exposures) or 220 (30 exposures) or Polaroid in the 6x4.5 format as the occasion demands. Like all its 7 viewfinders, 7 focusing screens, 11 lenses (including 2 zooms, a 55mm Perspective Control lens) and 2X Teleconverter, 21 eye correction lenses. close up equipment and other accessories the 6 different ETR-S magazines are designed for swift positive interchange.

BRONICA SQ-A

A "photographer's" camera and the culmination of nearly three decades of continuous technical development. The BRONICA SQ-A can easily be described as a professional work-horse that is equally at home in the studio or on location. Portraiture, action, macro, wild-life, industrial aerial, press - you name it and it's almost certain that the BRONICA SQ-A system can provide the ideal answer to cope with any situation. The SQ-A boasts the brightest screen of any 6x6 camera available today. It also offers a full compliment of practical features including full flash synchro at all speeds of the electronically controlled SEIKO shutter built into each lens, a choice of 7 interchangeable backs, 5 viewfinders (including 3 metering models) no less than 10 lenses and a teleconverter, 7 focusing screens and even 14 different eye correction lenses. With such a wide choice of top quality equipment to choose from the 6x6 enthusiast can tailor the BRONICA system for his own particular needs. He can also add and adapt as his needs change

Nothing has been forgotten - there is a depth of field pre-view lever, a battery check and a fast, smooth winding crank. Multiple exposures? Just a flick of a lever lets you double expose for special effects. The anatomically balanced ribbed rubber padding on the lower part of the body ensures easy, positive handling. To enjoy the speed and convenience of a modern 35 SLR simply fit the Speed Grip-S to the SQ-A and you'll have a rapid handling capability unmatched by any other brand of medium format camera. A battery check in the viewfinder also doubles as a signal that the shutter has closed after firing. Add to this the possibilities of using the enormous variety of 35mm emulsions in the 24x36 and 24x54mm formats PLUS the multitude of 120 and 220 films for 6x6 and 6x4.5 AND the choice of Polaroid pack films - then you begin to get some idea just how versatile the BRONICA SQ-A can be. BRONICA SQ-Am

The action shooting BRONICA 6x6 SLR with BUILT IN MOTOR DRIVE! The BRONICA SQ-AM retains all the design features (including double exposure capability and mirror lock) and accepts all SQ-A lenses and accessories. In addition the user can employ fast photo' sequence with up to 24 exposures on 220 or 36 on 35mm. The BRONICA SQ-AM can be set for single frame advance or continuous mode operation with a firing speed of up to 3 frames every 2 seconds. Its instant return mirror system virtually allows continuous viewing of the subject and motorised film advance is possible at all shutter speeds from 8 sec. - 1/500th (full flash sync. at all speeds) with any lens or accessory. Using fresh batteries (six AA size alkalinemanganese or NiCd) the BRONICA SQ-AM is capable of exposing about 40 rolls of 120 film. An optional external power pack is available if required. The SQ-AM is fitted with a remote control terminal and, like the SQ-A can produce a multitude of formats from a variety of film sizes. Anatomically designed integral hand grip and heavy duty adjustable strap gives comfortable, balanced control and security.

In the world of professional photography image quality is the criteria by which any camera is ultimately judged. factory, using state-of-the-art equipment like laser beam centreing machines to ensure precise optical alignment of all components. In the BRONICA armoury of ZENZANON lenses there is a model to cover virtually any assignment. From 40 mm super wide angle through to a 500 mm telephoto, including 2 zooms and a 2X autoteleconverter.



Apart from the choice of viewfinders described on the right BRONICA ETR-S users also have the choice of a Rotary eye-



level finder, a Sports frame finder and a Multiscope rotary finder attachment. A multiple exposure lever gives the ETR-S

user even greater creative scope. A battery check in the view finder also doubles as a signal to indicate that the shutter has closed after firing. Useful, when using slow speeds. A small feature, perhaps, but it is attention to such detail that demonstrates once more the leadership of BRONICA in medium format camera design. Because of its small size, its electronic features and its fast handling capability the BRONICA ETR-S is the ideal choice for the 35mm user who wishes to graduate to the medium format or the medium format enthusiast who demands versatility and reliability in one, compact unit.






Other features of the BRONICA SQ-A & SQ-AM BUILT IN MIRROR LOCK-UP SYSTEM

In most situations the photographer likes to see a viewfinder image right up to the very moment of exposure. There are, however some occasions when it is desirable to lock the mirror up to eliminate the very slight noise made by the mirror travel. Mirror lock-up can also prove invaluable for slow speeds in studio and close up work, macrophotography and long telephoto shots. The BRONICA SQ-A/SQ-AM viewing mirror system can be used in 3 modes:-

- N For normal viewing without lockup.
- S The mirror can be locked for one shot only, automatically returning to the normal viewing position after the shutter is fired.
- C Continuous mirror lock until returned to normal (N) viewing position by user.

AUTOMATIC ELECTRONIC COUPLING FILM SPEED DIAL


After loading the film into a magazine the BRONICA SQ-A/SQ-AM user simply sets the ASA film rating on a click stop dial situated on top of the magazine. From then on all through-the-lens metering finders will, without further adjustment, automatically, electronically couple to the pre-set speed. This completely eliminates the possibilities of film speed errors when changing magazines.



In addition to the finders mentioned on the right, BRONICA SQ-A/SQ-AM users have the choice of two other metering models.

BRONICA MF FINDER

A waist level through-the-lens manual metering finder with a colour coded 3 LED display showing correct exposure (green) and over and under in red. Registers full shutter speed range from 8 sec. to 1/500th (in ½ stop increments). Twin CdS cells giving full area average readings: EV4 -EV16 (at 100 ASA/IS0) Film speed range 25-3200 ASA/ISO. Magnification 1.0X (with 80mm lens). Ideal for low-angle, close-up, copying work, etc. requiring careful composition and critical focusing.





BRONICA ME PRISM FINDER S

An eye level through the lens manual metering prism finder with most of the features and all of the benefits of the MF model including the LED display. Magnification 0.75X (with 80mm lens). Like the MF finder the ME gives quick, accurate exposure readings via easy adjustment of its own shutter speed dial and the lens aperture ring.

COMPLETE BRONICA FILM BACK INTERCHANGEABILITY WITH THE WIDEST CHOICE OF MAGAZINES OF ANY ROLL FILM

This is where BRONICA really comes into its own! Both the BRONICA ETR-S and the SQ-A/SQ-AM user enjoys the choice of two 35mm backs. One producing up to the normal 36 exposures in the 24x36mm format and the other giving up to 23 exposures in a 24x54 panoramic format. This is in addition to the normal 120 back (15 exposures 6x4.5 on the ETR-S - 12 exposures 6x6 on the SQ-A/SQ-AM) and 220 back (30 exposures 6x4.5 on the ETR-S - 24 exposures 6x6 on the SQ-A/SQ-AM) A Polaroid back, accepting a wide range of Polaroid black and white and colour film packs, is available for both systems. This allows the BRONICA user to make an instant

appraisal of lighting, exposure, composition, etc. The BRONICA SQ-A/SQ-AM owner can also enjoy the benefits of the 6x4.5 format. Two 'I magazines, one for 120 (15 exposures) and 220 (30 exposures) are two further SQ-A/SQ-AM options. A 70mm back for bulk film provides up to 90 exposures in one shooting session for the professional ETR-S owner. Even in mid-roll or daylight all magazines are freely interchangeable within each system As desired, film can be loaded and unloaded before and after the back is attached to the camera. Just think you can start shooting with a Polaroid test shot -switch to 35mm Kodachrome -change over to roll film



Ektachrome -then on to roll film black and white -with interchanging taking only a few seconds and your

subject and camera set up undisturbed. That's BRONICA in action!

BRONICA SPEED GRIP

Another BRONICA exclusive. No other system offers such a unique accessory. The SPEED GRIP virtually gives your BRONICA camera the speed, confort and handling



convenience of a modern 35 SLR. Simply slides on to the camera and lets you cock the shutter, reset the mirror, advance the film and release the shutter - all with one hand. Also activates the LED readout when using the AE finder. The SPEED GRIP provides you with a degree of shooting freedom you can only enjoy with BRONICA!

CHOICE OF CLOSE UP EQUIPMENT

Close up work with the BRONICA system couldn't be simpler. BRONICA give you a choice of close up



systems - BELLOWS ATTACHMENT -EXTENSION TUBES - CLOSE UP LENS ATTACHMENT - all of which retain the fully automatic electronic control of aperture, shutter speeds and manual and auto metering finders The BRONICA BELLOWS E (for ETR-S) allows continuous magnification from 0.72X to 2.18X with 75mm lens and the BRONICA BELLOWS S (for SQ-A/SQ-AM) gives continuous magnification from 0.64X to 1.98X with the 80mm lens. There is a choice of two close up lens attachments for both systems, 3 extensions tubes for the ETR-S and 2 tubes for the SQ-A/SQ-AM systems.

A CHOICE OF VIEWFINDERS FOR EVERY PURPOSE

Apart from the finders mentioned on the left all BRONICA users have the choice of the normal collapsible WAIST LEVEL FINDER with flip-up interchangeable magnifier - a PRISM



FINDER with large, bright laterally correct image and interchangeable magnifier - and an AE PRISM FINDER allowing fully automatic and manual TTL exposure control. Couples to all shutter speeds and apertures. 2 silicon cells give you full area average readings EV4 - EV17 (100 ASA/ISO) LED illuminated shutter speed readout. Film speed range 25-3200 ASA/ISO.



Jointly developed by SFIKO and BRONICA, based on the latest "mechatronic" (mechanical electronic) technology. All BRONICA lenses, bellows and extension tubes are fitted with 6 tough high precision gold plated terminals thus ensuring highly accurate, consistent and reliable shutter and aperture electronic linkage. Each BRONICA lens incorporates its own SEIKO leaf shutter with the electronic shutter control circuit built into the camera body. This provides a very stable performance of all shutter speeds from 8 seconds to 1/500th sec. with full flash throughout the range. There is also a mechanically controlled speed of 1/500th sec. Because the SEIKO - BRONICA leaf shutters open fully at all speeds image distortion is completely eliminated.



Increased contrast and light transmission with consistent spectral transmittance drastically reduce the possibilities of colour 'shift' - this prevents colours becoming cooler or warmer when you use more than one lens with reversal colour film. All ZENZANON lenses are subject to continuous and painstaking quality control. Using the most up to date optical measuring equipment all lenses are constantly checked for element centration, contrast, resolving power, colour balance, flare and dimming as well as environmental changes. The end result is a range of outstanding lenses that have earned a world-wide reputation for the ultimate in optical






