

PARAMENDER Model 2

Parallax Compensation Attachment for the MAMIYA C

The **PARAMENDER** parallax compensator is used between the camera and the tripod head (or camera stand). The camera support of the **PARAMENDER** is lowered fully when focusing with the upper, viewing lens and ground glass screen. This positions the viewing lens exactly where the picture-taking lens will be when the shutter is released for the actual exposure, so the image thrown on the focusing screen is the exact replica in reverse of the final negative impression.

After adjusting focus, use handle to elevate camera as far as it will go. Picture-taking lens is now in the position previously occupied by the viewing lens, and the negative image will match that used for focusing and composing. Parallax is completely eliminated.

When the **PARAMENDER** is raised to the prescribed position, a stopper automatically actuates to lock it. When lowering the **PARAMENDER**, turn the handle while depressing a button located diagonally under the handle stem.

A knob located on the rear side for locking also can be used as a stopper aid.
