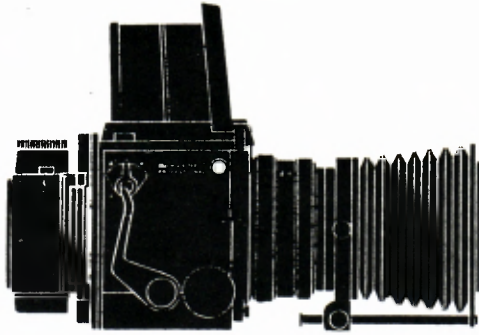




## Professional Bellows Lens Hoods for Mamiya RB 67 and RZ 67 Lenses

PRODUCT  
INFORMATION

Mamiya makes two models of bellows lens hoods for these lenses, Model G2 and G3. Both have the advantage of being adjustable for different focal length lenses, but they differ in many details.



### Mamiya Bellows Lens Hood G2

#### Model G2 Cat.#213-375

Maximum extension 4 1/4". Rear frame 3 1/2" square. Front frame 4 1/2" square.

Utilizes twin rails with rack and pinion mechanism. Focal length settings are engraved on rail. Attaches to lenses by first screwing a 77mm mounting ring, which is supplied with hood, into the lens front. Hood is then slipped on and fastened by a set-screw.

Extra mounting rings (#213-387) are available to install permanently on lenses. This makes it convenient to transfer hood from one lens to another.

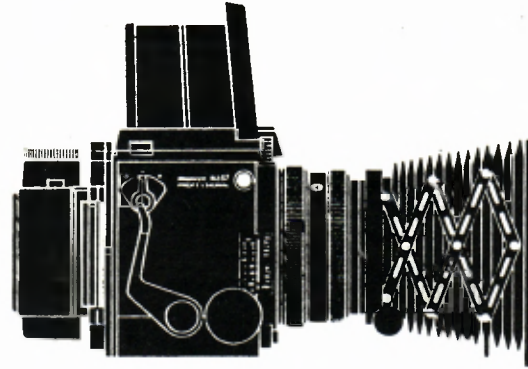
Cannot be used with zoom lens.

This hood accepts only 3" square, unmounted gelatine filters.

#### Model G3 Cat. #213-376

Maximum extension 7". Rear frame 4" square. Front frame 5 1/2" square. Utilizes side struts which are activated by geared drive screw. Comes supplied with ruler which shows settings for designated lenses, including zoom. Attaches to lenses by first screwing in 77mm mounting ring (the outer diameter of which is much larger than the one for Model G2) which is supplied with hood. Hood is then slipped on and fastened by set-screw.

Extra mounting rings (#213-378) are avail-

able to be permanently installed on lenses. This makes it convenient to transfer hood from one lens to another.

When used with the 100-200mm Zoom lens, a different mounting ring (Cat.#213-379) is required. While this ring has the same 77mm lens thread, its outer diameter is much larger and incorporates a rotating collar, riding on miniature ball bearings. This collar is necessary to permit the hood to remain stationary, while the focusing ring of the zoom lens is turned. (This requires a "Rotation Stopper", which is supplied with the Zoom mounting ring. The Rotation Stopper attaches to the bottom of the G3 hood and to the Lens Support Bracket, which now comes with the Zoom lens.)

The rear filter stage of the G3 accepts 3" square mounted and unmounted gelatine filters, as well as glass filters.

The front frame accepts standard 4 1/2 square vignetting masks and also has positioning pins for attaching the Front Bellows Hood, which is another accessory. The Front Bellows Hood, in turn, also accepts vignettters.
